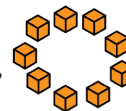
How many blocks?

If you count the blocks, how many do you think there will be?

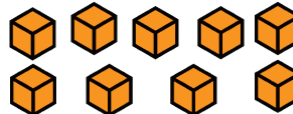

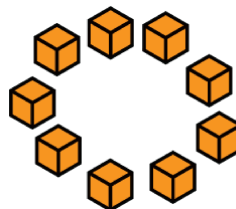
1. Arrange 9 blocks on a table in this pattern. (Other objects such as counters or pennies could be used instead of blocks.)



Say to the student, ***“How many blocks?”***

Listen and note what the student says and does.

2. After the student has given an answer to the problem above, slowly rearrange the blocks in a circle.



Say to the student, ***“If you count the blocks, how many do you think there will be?”***

Listen and note what the student says and does.
